
OUR HISTORY

In 1970 founder Dr. Charles D. Moody, Sr called upon fifteen prestigious African American superintendents from across the country to meet at O'Hare Marriott Hotel in Chicago, Illinois to discuss how to pool resources and to form an organization dedicated to helping African American schools.

One of Dr Moody's most famous-quotes "When one is in a struggle or battle, he looks around to see if he is alone. This human characteristic was one of the underlying factors in the formation of the National Alliance of Black School Superintendents." his powerful words sparked the interest of his fellow superintendents and in 1971 the National Alliance of Black School Educators was formed where they held their second meeting in Miami Beach, Florida.

Today, NABSE continues to be the premier organization advocating on behalf of African-American education spreading to Canada, Europe, and the Caribbean where children of color can get proper education.






