My name is Heidi Konstantopoulos, and I have the honor being hired by Principal Kemp twice. Initially I was hired as a classroom teacher and department leader. The second time I was hired as teacher on assignment to serve as a teacher mentor. Mr. Eric Kemp has been my supervisor, mentor, and leadership coach for the past seven years at Linda Abril Educational Academy.

Mr. Kemp's influence extends well beyond my own experience. He has coached and mentored numerous educational leaders, several of whom have advanced to Principal and Assistant Principal positions. Upon Eric Kemp's return, the school has demonstrated measurable improvement across all indicators.

He not only values a diverse student population but also actively recruits highly qualified and diverse representing our global community. Under his leadership, Linda Abril has become a model of multiculturalism, often described as "the United Nations of our district", that authentically reflects the community it serves. The cafeteria displays the flags from every continent and is inclusive of the African diaspora, symbolizing the school's commitment to inclusivity and cultural celebration.

Mr. Kemp leads with high expectations and accountability. He forges meaningful connections with all stakeholders, maintaining high standards of accountability while emphasizing the importance of wellness and family. He provides thoughtful support and intervention for staff experiencing personal or professional challenges.

Principal Kemp leads with a calm and respectful demeanor, treating every student, family, and staff member with dignity. Eric fosters an inclusive environment where all feel valued and supported. Principal Eric Kemp is an outstanding ambassador for NABSE and is worthy of the NABSE Principal of the Year Award.

It is with great enthusiasm that I nominate Mr. Eric Kemp for the Principal of the Year award. Over his many years of service, Mr. Kemp has exemplified the very qualities of transformational leadership, equity-driven focus, and unwavering commitment to students, staff, and community. His impact is especially significant given the challenging context in which he leads.

Since 2007, Mr. Kemp has served as a campus administrator in a school whose student body comprises approximately 97 % minority enrollment. In such settings, educational leaders must do more than manage; they must deeply understand culturally responsive practices, focus relentlessly on closing opportunity gaps, and earn trust across divergent stakeholder groups. Mr. Kemp has not only done this — he has excelled. After ten years as an Assistant Principal, he stepped into principal-level leadership roles with strong credibility and a track record of service.

Under Mr. Kemp's leadership, historically underserved student populations; particularly Black and Brown students; have shown sustained increases in graduation rates. In doing so, he has built trust across culturally and linguistically diverse constituencies; an essential competency in a 97 % minority school setting.

Mr. Kemp is widely regarded as a high achiever, consummately professional, and an inspirational mentor. Across his career, many emerging school leaders, teachers, and students have looked to him for guidance, encouragement, and example. He is not content to rest on past success; he invests in continuous learning, adapts to changing needs, and models equity-focused leadership daily.

Beyond his school, he is a recognized **community leader**. He engages intentionally with local civic institutions, parent groups, faith organizations, and stakeholder networks, ensuring that the school is not isolated but integrated within the broader community. Even amid a demanding role, he makes time to listen, reach out, and advocate for his school's students and families.
