Her academic journey includes earning a Bachelor of Science in Organizational Management from Crichton College in 2007, followed by a Master of Business Administration in 2010 and a Master of Healthcare Administration in 2013, both from Texas Woman's University Houston Campus.

Since 1998, Mrs. Harmon has been a Certified Pharmacy Technician, and her professional background predominantly revolves around the healthcare sector, encompassing roles in home health care, Allied Health Education, and the pharmaceutical field. She served as the Allied Health Department Chairperson and Externship Coordinator in a post-secondary proprietary school setting.

Her career path eventually led her to Alief ISD. She started at Hastings High School as a CTE Health Science Technology teacher. Currently, Mrs. Harmon teaches Health Science Theory with Clinical Rotation and Health Science Theory- Patient Care Technician at the Marshall Center for Advanced Careers. Her instructional repertoire also includes courses such as Medical Terminology and Principles of Health Science.
